

2007/2008 Iraq / Afghanistan Serviceman's Hunt

Purpose

This serves as a "Thank you" to United States service personnel who have served in Iraq or Afghanistan.

Who is eligible?

Any man or woman who served honorably in the Armed Forces of the United States while deployed on orders to Iraq or Afghanistan since Sept 11, 2001 and is invited by a landowner.

When?

The land owner may set up any date providing:

1. Must request a special harvest tag at least two (2) weeks before the hunt.
2. Must have received the special harvest tag for the hunt. (see sample below)

Conditions / Limitations

1. Harvest tag may be used for any regulated species.
2. Harvest tag does not count against landowner host's quota.
3. Harvest tag may be used on tracts not owned by landowner host if the other landowner agrees.
4. Harvest tag must be filled out and signed by landowner host and guest.
5. Landowner host may not receive monetary compensation for a hunt on this harvest tag.
6. This is a one time only per individual serviceman.
7. State of Texas hunting regulations as well as YOLA Hunting Regulations, including permission forms, but excluding species moratoriums and other specifically exempted rules, must be followed.
